#### 1.2 ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL

- 1. Admission is confined to kindergarten only. Admission to classes other than K.G. will be feasible only if there is any vacant seat.
- Preferably, the students on transfer from a school recognized by CBSE are admitted to the school. However, students from the institution affiliated with state boards can also be considered for admission.
- 3. The parents who wish to get their children enrolled in the school must get their names registered before 15th February by all means.
- 4. Admission is permissible usually in the beginning of the session. However, in case a seat is vacant, admission can be granted in the mid session. No admission is made until the child has passed the scholastic aptitude test in compulsory subjects.
- 5. A student who has attended a recognized school will not be admitted without a school leaving certificate (duly countersigned), Character certificate from the school last attended and an original date of birth certificate issued by the competent authority.
- 6. A month's notice is required before the withdrawal of a student from the school; failing which all the dues till date will be charged. Those who want to leave the school in April must apply before 31st March by all means, lest they should pay all the annual charges due to them for the ensuing session along with the monthly fee for the month of April.
- 7. School Leaving Certificate will be issued only when all the dues are paid and a 'No Dues Slip' is submitted duly signed by all concerned.
- 8. The final authority for admitting or refusing admission will be the Principal and the school cabinet.

## 3. EXAMINATION POLICY (2025-26)

#### 3.1 ELIGIBILITY:

- Sudents of all the classes are required to attend at least 75% of the total lectures delivered in each subject inclusive of additional, optional and practicals, failing which his/her admission for the Annual Board Exams will be detained.
- Apart from attending the classes a student's behaviour should be found satisfactory by the teachers and the Principal in and outside the classroom during the session.
- iii) It will be mandatory for all the students to ensure their presence in Periodic Tests, Half yearly and Annual Exams. Even in case of dire emergency a student must get his/her leave sactioned in advance from the Principal.
- iv) The final authority for sending admission for the Board Examination will be the Principal and the school-cabinet, however it will be as per the CBSE Rules.

## 4. COUNSELLING SESSIONS FOR PARENTS & STUDENTS

Regular guidance and counseling sessions are held for students to help them to deal with psychological problems and with issues surrounding their lives. Counselling facilitates better communication skills and enhances the personalities of students. Parents and students are given comprehensive advice on career, courses and jobs that enable them to make a better choice.





#### 2.3 LEAVE RULES

- 1. The students are expected to be regular in attending the school.
- 2. In case of absence from school, due information must be sent by the parents or guardian in the form of written prescribed application form; in case of prolonged illness, the application must be supported by a Medical Certificate by the competent authority.
- 3. Leave will be granted by the Principal only on the recommendation of the class teacher/coordinator.
- 4. If a student abstains from the school for six days continuously in a month without the leave application, his/her name will be struck off from the rolls of the school and will be fined Rs. 100/- to get reinstate.
- 5. A fine of Rs. 10/- per day will be charged from students abstaining from the school without proper application, from late-comers and from uniform defaulters.
- 6. No leave will be granted under the pretext of going abroad.
- 7. Absence during the examination days will entail a fine of Rs. 100/- each subject. However, the leave can be sanctioned under extra-ordinary circumstances and that also with the prior permission of the Principal on the Medical grounds only.
- 8. Leave on the days of school-functions can be sanctioned in advance by the Principal only. In case of absence, a special fine may be charged.
- 9. Students are expected to attend at least 75% school meetings to earn eligibility for the Annual Board Examination.



## 5. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

## PARENTS' OBLIGATIONS

- 2. Submit all the required documents as prescribed for admission at the time of admission only and fill up the admission form with utmost accuracy.
- 3. Verify the permit, licence and antecedents of the driver as well as the helper.
- 4. Visit the school once a month at the time of P.T. Meet positively.
- 5. Pay the dues of your ward before 20th of every quarter (April, July, Oct., Jan.).
- Clear all the school dues till date before applying for Transfer Certificate.
- 7. Submit one month's notice prior to the withdrawal of your ward from the school.
- 8. Avoid arranging any appointment of your ward with doctors, dentists during school hours.
- 9. Make your own arrangements for the transportation of your ward.
- 10. Ensure that your ward doesn't bring any expensive articles/forbidden items to school.
- 11. Don't intentionally withhold from revealing any serious health issues of your ward to the class teacher.
- 12. Deposit transportation fee for at least six months in advance. If a child withdraws his name from school transport even then he will have to pay six months fee.
- 13. Give feedback regarding the performance of your ward regularly.
- 14. Ensure the participation of your ward in each and every activity of the school.
- 15. Maintain cordiality with the staff members.
- 16. Discourage your child from the private tuition and encourage him for 'Learning by Doing'.
- 17. Ensure the punctuality, regularity, cleanliness of uniform & personal hygiene of your wards.
- 18. Give suggestions/observations in the interest of the Institution.
- 19. All the parents are expected to be present during their ward's class show.

## STUDENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Wearing any type of Fashion Accessory or Jewellery (bracelets, silver kada of large size, headbands, smart watches, rings, earings, chain, goggles) is strictly prohibited in the school campus.
- 2. Hair Style must be neat & tidy (Girls with two braids & boys with short and sober hair cut).
- 3. Mobile phones are not allowed in the school vicinity.
- 4. English Speaking is mandatory in the school premises.
- 5. Students below the age of 18 years are not allowed to bring any type of vehicle in the school.
- 6. Arriving too early in the school campus is not allowed.
- 7. Leaving the school premises on any pretext after entering is not permitted.
- 8. Loitering about outside the school gate or crowding the street vendors to while away time is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Bullying in any form either physically or mentally or through social media is a serious offence and if anyone is found to be enganged in such activities, he/she will be suspended from the school with immediate effect.
- 10. Inviting any of your friends to the school campus from outside will not be appreciated.
- 11. Duplicate copy of 'School Diary' will be issued only with the consent of the Principal, after verification of the request and on a payment of Rs. 60/-.
- 12. Warning Cards will be issued to the indisciplined children. Indisciplinary action will be taken against the child who gets three warning cards.
- 13. Students must wear their ID cards at all times during school hours and while travelling on the school bus, failure to do so will result in a fine of Rs. 200/-.
- 14. Students must bring their school diary to school every day. A fine of Rs. 100/- will be imposed for not bringing the diary. Tearing pages or improper maintenance will also result in a fine for a new diary.
- 15.Non-Sikh boys should get their hair cut at regular intervals. Coloring/dyeing hair and wearing of earpins/rings are strictly prohibited. Girls should either cut their hair short or neatly tie in plaits. A fine of Rs.100/- will be imposed in case of non-compliance.

- 18. Any damage done to the school property will be made good by the concerned students together with a fine money imposed for such an offence.

- 21. The school reserves the right to terminate any student whose progress in studies is unsatisfactory or whose conduct is a bad example for other children.
- 22. Bringing fireworks/bursting or extending any kind of support for exploding crackers or splashing water or colour or flying kite in the school premises or outside in the vicinity of the school is strictly prohibited, even during festival time. Non-compliance of these instructions can result in expulsion from the school.
- 23. Students must come to school in neat and clean uniform only. This rule applies even when they come to school for any purpose other than attending class or even after school hours. Scribbling on uniform or its improper wearing is punishable.
