Interschool and Open Competiton Common Instructions for public participation

through parents:-

- Participation will be strictly as per the class.
 mentioned for each event.
- Participants must carry school Id Card or authority letter from school as a proof.
- Participants must bring their own materials, costumes, and props as required.
- Time limits will be strictly followed as per activity rules.
- Judging will be based on pre-defined rubrics for each event.
- One of the parents must accompany the child but cannot assist during performances.
- Background music or song for any item should be submitted to host school by 10th August, 2025.
- If Tricolour is used, its sanctity should be maintained.
- The decision of judges will be final.
- Last date for registration: 5th Aug, 2025.
- Participation certificates will be awarded to all; winners will be awarded.

Common Instructions for Participation through schools:

- Participation will be strictly as per the class mentioned for each event.
- Participants must carry school Id Card as a proof.
- Each school may send 5 entries per event for individual event and 2 entries for group event.
- Participants must bring their own materials, costumes, and props as required.
- Time limits will be strictly followed as per activity rules.
- Judging will be based on pre-defined rubrics for each event.
- Teachers may accompany students but cannot assist during performances.
- Background music or song for any item should be submitte to host school by 10th August, 2025
- If Tricolour is used, its sanctity should be maintained.
- The decision of judges will be final.
- Last date for registration: 5th Aug ,2025
- Participation certificates will be awarded to all; winners will be awarded.

Fancy Dress Competition

Class: Pre nursery and Nursery

Theme: Janmashtami & Mythological Characters

Activity Type: Individual Presentation

Rules:-

- Each participant must dress up as a mythological or Janmashtami-themed character (e.g., Krishna, Radha, Sudama, Hanuman, Ganesha, etc.).
- Time limit: 1-2 minute per participant.
- Background music (if any) must be submitted in advance in MP3 format.
- Simple dialogues or lines to be spoken by the child (mandatory).
- Props are allowed but must be safe, relevant and easy to carry.
- Parents/teachers may assist with dressing up but not during the performance.
- Costumes should be age-appropriate and culturally respectful.

Fancy Dress Competition

Theme: Mischievous Makhan Chor & Radha, Meera, Gopiyaan

Class: LKG

Activity Type: Individual Presentation Rules:

- Participants must dress up as either Radha or Krishna (Makhan Chor).
- Each participant will get 1-2 minute to walk or pose on stage.
- Light background music can be played during the performance (submit in advance).
- Simple, short dialogues or a bhajan line must be presented by the child.
- Props such as a matki, flute, peacock feather, iktaara or flower basket may be used. (safe and manageable).
- Costumes should be age-appropriate and reflect traditional attire.
 - Parents/teachers may guide children during the entry/exit but not during the stage time.

Dance Competition

Theme: Yashodha & Krishna - A Bond of Love

Class: UKG

Activity Type: Team Presentation (No. of participants 2-8)

Rules:

- Participants must dress up as Yashodha Maiya and Bal Krishna.
- Each team will get 4-6 minute on stage for their performance.
- Relevant and safe Props can be used.
- Costumes must be traditional and suitable for the character.
- Performances should maintain cultural sensitivity and be age-appropriate.
- Parents/teachers may accompany the child until stage entry but not during the performance.

Handi Decoration Competition

Theme: Celebrating Janmashtami with Creativity

Class: I

Activity Type: Individual Presentation


Rules:

- Handi will be provided at the venue.Participant s are required to deposit Rs 100 for that.
- All decoration materials (glitter, paints, mirrors, lace, stickers, beads, etc.) must be brought by the participant.
- Time limit: 90 min
- Assistance by parents/guardians is not allowed during the competition.
- Judging will be based solely on the work done during the event.
- Participants should maintain cleanliness at their workstations.

- Costumes and props should be suitable for a school event and must be arranged by the participants' school.

Activity Type: Individual

RULES:

- Only A3 size drawing sheets will be provided by the host school. All other materials (colours, pencils etc.) must be brought by the participants.

Points to be noted:

- Students must write their name, class, father's name
 & school name on the back of the sheet only.
- Students will use only crayons, sketch pens, oil pastels and pencil colours.
