Interschool and Open Competition

Common Instructions for public participation through parents :-

- Participation will be strictly as per the class mentioned for each event.
- Participants must carry school Id Card or authority letter from school as a proof.
- Participants must bring their own materials, costumes, and props as required.
- Time limits will be strictly followed as per activity rules.
- Judging will be based on pre-defined rubrics for each event.
- One of the parents must accompany the child but cannot assist during performances.
- Background music or song for any item should be submitted to host school by 10th August ,2025 .
- If Tricolour is used ,its sanctity should be maintained.
- The decision of judges will be final.
- Last date for registration: 5th Aug ,2025.
- Participation certificates will be awarded to all; winners will be awarded.

Common Instructions for Participation through schools:

- **Participation will be strictly as per the class mentioned for each event.**
- **Participants must carry school Id Card as a proof.**
- **Each school may send 5 entries per event for individual event and 2 entries for group event.**
- **Participants must bring their own materials, costumes, and props as required.**
- **Time limits will be strictly followed as per activity rules.**
- **Judging will be based on pre-defined rubrics for each event.**
- **Teachers may accompany students but cannot assist during performances.**
- **Background music or song for any item should be submitte to host school by 10th August ,2025**
- **If Tricolour is used,its sanctity should be maintained.**
- **The decision of judges will be final.**
- **Last date for registration: 5th Aug ,2025**
- **Participation certificates will be awarded to all; winners will be awarded.**

Fancy Dress Competition

Class : Pre nursery and Nursery

Theme: Janmashtami & Mythological Characters

Activity Type: Individual Presentation

Rules:-

- Each participant must dress up as a mythological or Janmashtami-themed character (e.g., Krishna, Radha, Sudama, Hanuman, Ganesha, etc.).
- Time limit: 1-2 minute per participant.
- Background music (if any) must be submitted in advance in MP3 format.
- Simple dialogues or lines to be spoken by the child (mandatory).
- Props are allowed but must be safe, relevant and easy to carry.
- Parents/teachers may assist with dressing up but not during the performance.
- Costumes should be age-appropriate and culturally respectful.

- Costume creativity & relevance to theme 4
- Confidence and stage presence 3
- Expression/Dialogue 3

Fancy Dress Competition

Theme: Mischievous Makhan Chor & Radha, Meera, Gopiyaan

Class: LKG

Activity Type: Individual Presentation

Rules:

- Participants must dress up as either Radha or Krishna (Makhan Chor).
- Each participant will get 1-2 minute to walk or pose on stage.
- Light background music can be played during the performance (submit in advance).
- Simple, short dialogues or a bhajan line must be presented by the child.
- Props such as a matki, flute, peacock feather, iktaara or flower basket may be used. (safe and manageable).
- Costumes should be age-appropriate and reflect traditional attire.
- Parents/teachers may guide children during the entry/exit but not during the stage time.

- Dialogue delivery or Bhajan Gayan 2

Dance Competition

Theme: Yashodha & Krishna – A Bond of Love

Class: UKG

Activity Type: Team Presentation (No. of participants 2-8)

Rules:

- Participants must dress up as Yashodha Maiya and Bal Krishna.
- Each team will get 4-6 minute on stage for their performance.
- Relevant and safe Props can be used .
- Costumes must be traditional and suitable for the character.
- Performances should maintain cultural sensitivity and be age-appropriate.
- Parents/teachers may accompany the child until stage entry but not during the performance.

Rubrics

- Costume creativity & character accuracy 2
- Expression & gestures 2
- Team coordination 4
- Use of props and choice of songs 2

Handi Decoration Competition

Theme: Celebrating Janmashtami with Creativity

Class: I

Activity Type: Individual Presentation

Rules:

- Handi will be provided at the venue. Participants are required to deposit Rs 100 for that.
- All decoration materials (glitter, paints, mirrors, lace, stickers, beads, etc.) must be brought by the participant.
- Time limit: 90 min
- Assistance by parents/guardians is not allowed during the competition.
- Judging will be based solely on the work done during the event.
- Participants should maintain cleanliness at their workstations.

Rubrics

- Creativity & beautification 5
- Neatness & finishing 3
- Relevance to theme (Janmashtami feel) 2



Theme: Anecdotes from Krishna's Life

Class: II

Activity Type: Group Skit / Tableau Presentation

Rules:

- Each group will consist of 5–8 students.
- The presentation should be based on a well-known Krishna anecdote.
- Duration: 3–5 minutes per group.
- Costumes and props should be appropriate and manageable by students.
- Background music or narration can be used .
- Teachers/parents may help in preparation but not during the actual performance.
- Each group must present brief introduction of the anecdote through narrator before the performance begins.

Rubrics (out of 20)

- Story relevance and moral message 5
- Team coordination and role clarity 4
- Expression, voice, and stage presence 4
- Costume and props usage 3
- Creativity in presentation (music, gestures, etc.) 4



Solo Dance Presentation

Theme: Patriotism

Class: III

Activity Type: Dance

RULES:

- **Duration: 3–5 minutes per item.**
- **Costumes and props should be appropriate and manageable by students.**
- **Teachers/parents may help in preparation but not during the actual performance**

Rubrics

- **Expression-2**
- **Creativity-2**
- **Rhythm-2**
- **Confidence-2**
- **Costume-2.**

Theme: Patriotism

Class: IV

Activity Type: Group Dance

RULES:

- Each group must consist of 8 to 10 participants from the same school.
- The dance must be based on a patriotic theme and reflect Indian culture, unity or national pride.
- Each group will be allotted 4 to 6 minutes for their performance, including stage setup and exit.
- Costumes and props should be suitable for a school event and must be arranged by the participants' school.

Rubrics:

- Theme relevance-3
- Synchronisation-3
- Expressions-2
- Costume-2



POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

Theme: MY INDIA, MY PRIDE

Class: IV

Activity Type: Individual

RULES:

- Posters must reflect the theme "India - My Pride" and showcase the spirit, culture, or achievements of India.
- Each participant will be given 90 minutes to complete the poster during the competition.
- Only A3 size drawing sheets will be provided by the host school. All other materials (colours, pencils etc.) must be brought by the participants.

Points to be noted:

- Artwork must be original and hand-drawn.
- Students must write their name, class, father's name & school name on the back of the sheet only.
- Students will use only crayons, sketch pens , oil pastels and pencil colours.

DECLAMATION COMPETITION

Theme: – MY VISION FOR INDIA IN 2050

Class: V

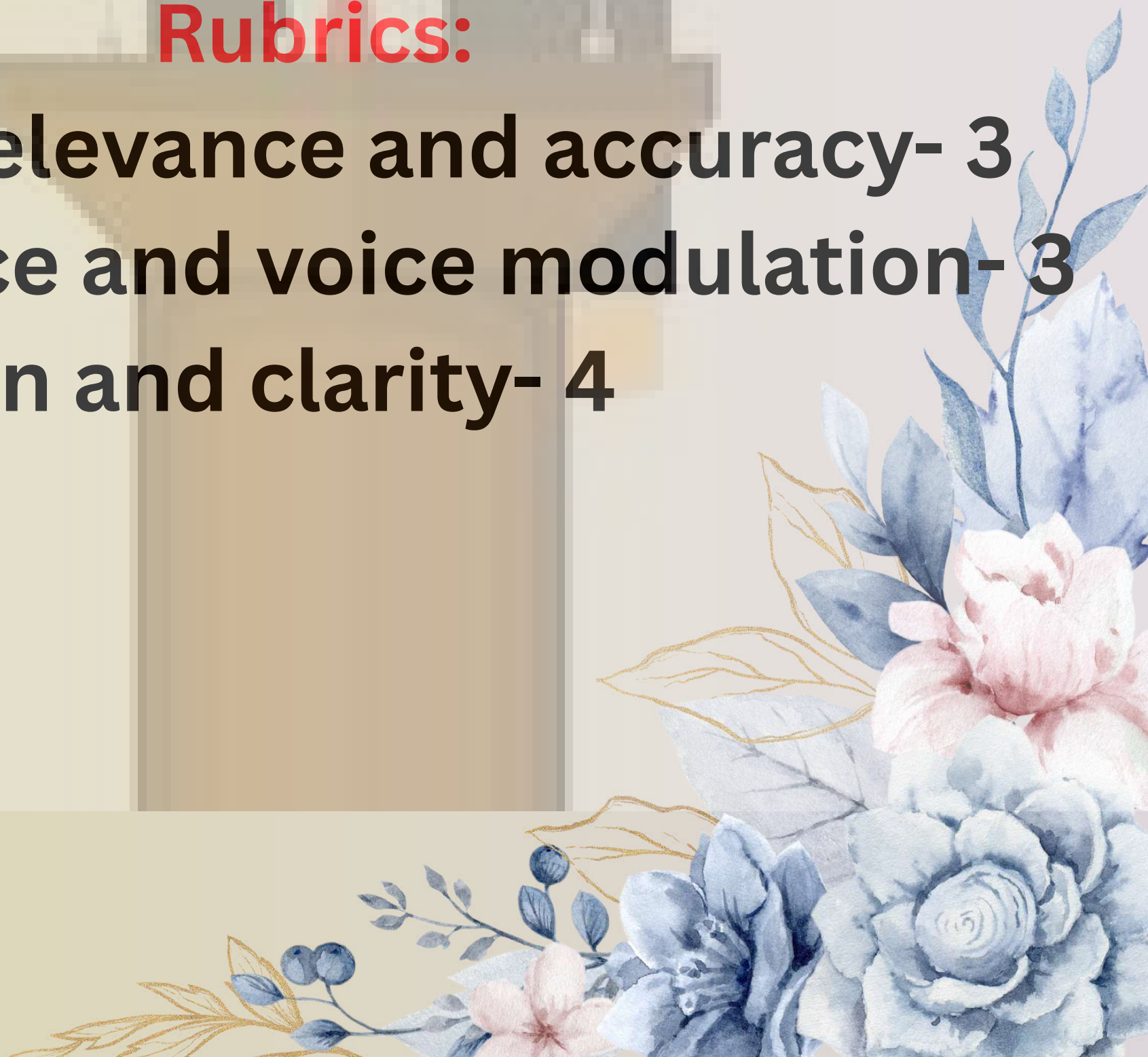
Activity Type: Individual

RULES

- The participant can use any language (English, hindi or Punjabi).
- Participants should maintain clarity and proper pronunciation.
- The speech must be original and preferably written by the student.
- Paper reading is not allowed.

Rubrics:

- Confidence and voice modulation- 3
- Expression and clarity- 4



QUIZ COMPETITION

Class: V

Activity Type: Team of 4 members

TOPICS-

RULES:

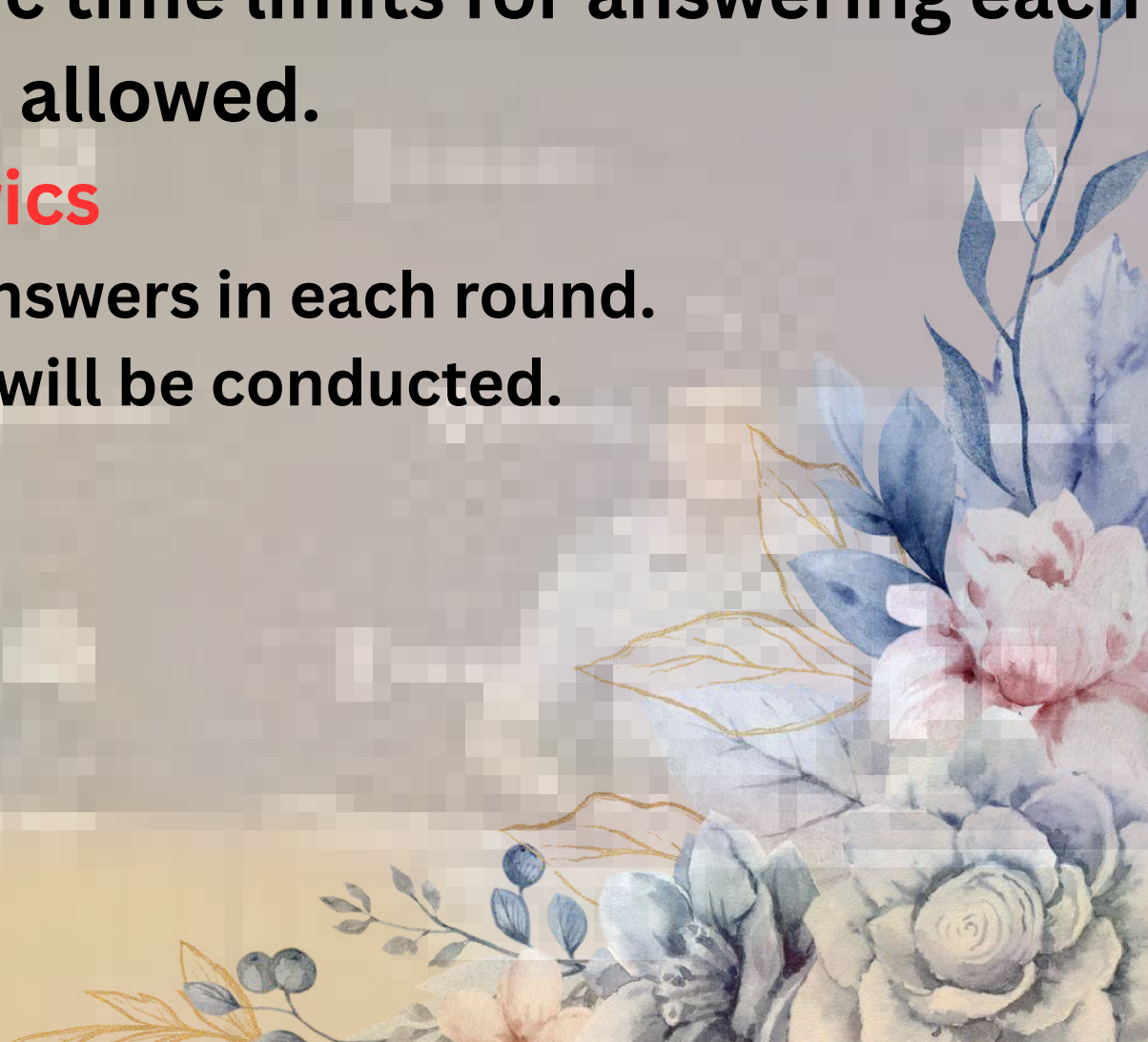
- The final four teams will be selected through a screening test on the same day.
